Bridget Tietz Environmental Service Assistant:



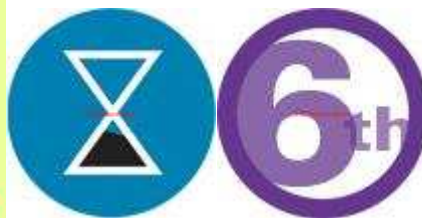
